| 2007-312 | 8/21/2007 | Approves City participation in the University Av Improvements & ARTWalk2 Enhancements Project. Also authorizes the Mayor to enter into necessary agreements with NYSDOT to administer the project |
| 2007-313 | 8/21/2007 | Establishes a maximum compensation for a professional services agreement with Bergmann for \$210,000 for engineering planning & preliminary design of the project. The transmittal for that item stated that requests for letters of interest for the engineering planning and preliminary design work were sent to the fifteen firms on the State's Local Design Services Agreement list; ten submitted letters of interest. A selection committee, consisting of City personnel and representatives of the NYSDOT and the Memorial Art Gallery, narrowed the list to three – Bergmann Associates, Erdman, Anthony & Associates and LaBella Associates. The selection of Bergmann Associates was based upon their qualifications and knowledge of the Project. |
| 2008-97 | 3/18/2008 | Establishes a maximum compensation for an amendatory professional services agreement with Bergmann for \$35,000 for coordinate aspects of the project involving the Memorial Art Gallery (MAG). MAG will commission an artist to design artworks for the MAG property and the Goodman Street/University Avenue intersection. Services also include relevant planning, coordinating and holding informational meetings for the project area that will assist in the development of various ARTWalk elements. |
| 2009-156 | 5/12/2009 | Establishes a maximum compensation for an amendatory professional services agreement with Bergmann for \$930,000 for final design engineering services for the project. Also appropriates the \$3.839M of Federal stimulus ARRA funding for the project. Also appropriates the \$1.376M of Federal, and \$0.258M of NYS, transportation funding earmarked by Congresswoman Slaughter. |
| 2009-386 | 11/9/2009 | Amends Ordinance 2009-156 to pay for work between May 2009 and August 2009 from City funding instead of ARRA funding. Also amends that ordinance to remove any Federal or NYS transportation earmark funding from the design contract. Also amends the budget to transfer \$288,850 from contingency to pay for those changes to the final design work. Also establishes maximum compensations for two professional services agreements for project appraisal services. |
| 2009-412 | 12/15/2009 | Amends Ordinance 2009-386 to change the budget amendment amount from \$288,850 to \$288,900. |
| 2009-432 | 12/15/2009 | Approves all of the pavement width modifications to University Avenue and North Goodman Street for the project. |
| 2009-433 | 12/15/2009 | Authorizes the acquisition of all permanent and temporary easements, except for MAG, for the public art installation and street improvements. Also authorizes the Mayor to enter into agreements for maintenance of project features. |
| 2010-21 | 1/19/2010 | Authorizes the acquisition of all permanent and temporary easements for MAG and Village Gate for the public art installation and street improvements. |
| 2010-22 | 1/19/2010 | Establishes a maximum compensation of \$150,000 for professional services with Cliff Garten Studios for <i>Needle & Spindle</i> . Also, establishes a maximum compensation of \$150,000 for professional services with Adam Frank, Inc. for <i>Spectator</i> . Also, establishes a maximum compensation of \$359,000 for other professional services with artists for public art. Also, establishes a maximum compensation of \$100,000 for professional services with Living Lenses for <i>Travelling through Stillness</i> . Also authorizes the Mayor to enter into with NYS for an EDCAP grant secured by Senator Robach and appropriates \$250,000 of EDCAP funding. |
| LIO 1611 | 1/19/2010 | Authorizes an Enhancement District for RMSC and establishes a maximum District assessment of \$100,000. Also authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement with RMSC for maintenance of the improvements and repayment of the District assessment. |
| 2010-123 | 4/13/2010 | Establishes a maximum authorization for an amendatory professional services agreement with Cliff Garten Studios for \$65,000 for additional public art. |
| LIO 1616 | 4/13/2010 | Authorizes an Enhancement District for Village Gate and establishes a maximum District assessment of \$65,000. |
| 2010-128 | 4/13/2010 | Approves further changes to the pavement widths to University Avenue and North Goodman Street for the project. |
| 2010-308 | 8/17/2010 | Establishes a maximum compensation for an amendatory professional services agreement with Bergmann for \$25,000 for to allow an amendment to their sub-contract with ARTWalk of Rochester, Inc. to administer artistic enhancements to functional street elements such as sidewalks, benches, light poles, manhole covers, signal cabinets, and similar features including oversight of the art selection process, promotion and hosting of local meetings for public input and events, and increased involvement in design workshops and educational lecture series that are part of the overall project. |
| 2010-333 | 9/21/2010 | Amends Ordinance 2010-21 related to some of the easements for the project. |
